The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the Federation of Independent Transportation Employees (FITE) on August 30, 2017, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Flight Attendants,” employees of ExpressJet Airlines, Inc.

At the time this application was received, these employees were represented by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers. *See Atlantic Southeast Airlines*, 39 NMB 259 (2011).


The Board assigned Investigator Andres Yoder to investigate.

FINDINGS

The investigation established that FITE has failed to support its application with the required number of authorizations from employees in the craft or class as set forth in Part 1206.2(a) of the Board’s Rules.

Therefore, the Board finds no basis upon which to proceed in this matter and the application is hereby dismissed, subject to Part 1206.4(b)(2) of the Board's Rules.
