The services of the National Mediation Board (NMB or Board) were invoked by the International Brotherhood of Teamsters (IBT) on March 24, 2004, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Crew Schedulers," employees of ASTAR Air Cargo, Inc.

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Cristina A. Bonaca to investigate.

Subsequently, Don Treichler, Director of IBT's Airline Division, filed a letter with the NMB which stated: "This letter is to inform you that the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Airline Division hereby withdraws its application in the above case."

On the basis of this letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7005 and dismisses the application.
