The services of the National Mediation Board (NMB or Board) were invoked by the International Association of Machinists & Aerospace Workers, AFL-CIO (IAM) on March 10, 2004, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Flight Attendants,” employees of ExpressJet Airlines, Inc.

The Board assigned Investigators Susanna C. Fisher and Eileen M. Hennessey to investigate.

Subsequently, Robert S. Clayman, Counsel for the IAM filed a letter with the NMB which stated, “By this letter, the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, AFL-CIO, (IAM) is hereby notifying the National Mediation Board that it is withdrawing its application in the above-referenced case.”

On the basis of this letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7008 and dismisses the application.
