The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the Transport Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO (TWU) on February 20, 2008, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Maintenance Controllers," employees of Hawaiian Airlines, Inc. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were represented by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, AFL-CIO.

The Board assigned Investigator Harry E. Jones to investigate.

Subsequently, TWU General Counsel David B. Rosen filed a letter with the NMB which stated, "The Transport Workers Union of America hereby withdraws petition filed in the above mentioned case."

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7159 and dismisses the application.
