The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the United Transportation Union (UTU) on October 14, 2008, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Train & Engine Service Employees,” employees of Trans-Global Solutions, Inc. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Norman L. Graber to investigate.

Subsequently, the UTU filed a letter with the NMB which stated, “Please note that at this time, United Transportation Union wishes to withdraw its petition in the above-named matter.”

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7181 and dismisses the application.
