DISMISSAL-WITHDRAWN DURING INVESTIGATION

The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the Oklahoma Railroad Maintenance Association (ORMA) on January 20, 2010, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Maintenance of Way Employees," employees of Stillwater Central Railroad (Carrier).

The Board assigned Investigator Eileen M. Hennessey to investigate.

At the time this application was received, these employees were represented by the Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employes-IBT (BMWE) (R-7132, Stillwater Central, 35 NMB 38 (2008)). On June 2, 2010 the BMWE requested that the Board "vacate" its certification in R-7132. The Board revoked the certification on June 4, 2010. Stillwater Central, 37 NMB 204 (2010).

On June 7, 2010, ORMA filed a letter with the NMB which stated, "[o]n behalf of the Oklahoma Railroad Maintenance Association, I would like to withdraw the ORMA as a potential representative of the Employees of the Maintenance of Way Craft of the Stillwater Central Railroad."

On the basis of this letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby dismisses the application and closes this case subject to Part 1206.4(b)(3) of the NMB's Rules.
