REVOCATION OF  
CERTIFICATIONS

August 18, 2010

On August 11, 2010, Robert A. Scardelletti, International President of the Transportation Communications International Union (TCU) addressed a letter to the National Mediation Board (NMB), stating “TCU disclaims interest in the Clerical, Office, Station and Storehouse Employees craft or class at the Illinois & Midland Railway Company. TCU previously held this certification in [NMB Case] Number R-6556. TCU also disclaims interest in the Carmen craft or class at the Illinois & Midland Railway Company. TCU previously held this certification in [NMB Case] Number R-6555.”

The TCU was certified in NMB Case No. R-6555 as the representative of the craft or class of Carmen at Illinois and Midland Railroad. *Illinois & Midland R.R.*, 25 NMB 164 (1997). The TCU was certified in NMB Case No. R-6556 as the representative of the craft or class of Clerical Office Station and Storehouse Employees at Illinois and Midland Railroad. *Illinois & Midland R.R.*, 25 NMB 166 (1997).

On the basis of the above disclaimer, the NMB hereby revokes, effective August 18, 2010, the certifications issued to the TCU in the NMB Case Nos. R-6555 and R-6556.
