The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM) on November 18, 2010, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Office Clerical Employees," employees of Delta Air Lines, Inc. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were represented in part by IAM and unrepresented in part.

The Board assigned Investigator Maria-Kate Dowling to investigate.

FINDINGS

The investigation established that the Organization had failed to support its application with the required number of authorizations from employees in the craft or class as set forth in Part 1206.2(b) of the Board's Rules.

Therefore, the Board finds no basis upon which to proceed in this matter and the application is hereby dismissed pursuant to Part 1206.4 (b)(2) of the Board's Rules.
