The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the United Transportation Union (UTU) on February 17, 2011, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Pilots,” employees of Vision Airlines, Inc. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Norman L. Graber to investigate.

Subsequently, the UTU filed a letter with the NMB which stated that “UTU respectfully submits its withdrawal of the above-captioned representation application.”

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby dismisses the application pursuant to Part 1206.4 (b)(3) of the Board's Rules.
