The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the National Transportation Supervisors Association (NTSA) on April 21, 2011, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Assistant Manager Facilities, Staff Manager and Assistant Staff Manager,” employees of Long Island Rail Road (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Susanna F. Parker to investigate.

Subsequently, the NTSA filed a letter with the NMB which stated that the NTSA “withdraws its application for representation.”

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7292 and dismisses the application.
