The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked by the United Transportation Union (UTU) on May 5, 2011, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as “Train and Engine Service Employees,” employees of Industrial Railway Switching & Services, Inc. (Carrier).

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Norman L. Graber to investigate.

Subsequently, UTU filed a letter with the NMB which stated that UTU “submits its withdrawal of the . . . representation application.”

On the basis of the letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7293 and dismisses the application.
