DISMISSAL

January 24, 2020

The services of the National Mediation Board (Board) were invoked on November 21, 2019 by Greg DeBourge, pursuant to the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, seeking to decertify the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Airline Division as the representative of personnel described as “Flight Deck Crewmembers,” employees of Kalitta Charters II (Carrier).

The Board assigned Investigator Norman L. Graber to investigate.

FINDINGS

The investigation disclosed that a dispute existed among the craft or class of Flight Deck Crewmembers, and by direction of the Board, the Investigator was instructed to conduct an election to determine the employees' representation choice.

The following is the result of the election as reported by Investigator Graber.

<u>Election Results for Flight Deck Crewmembers</u>	
Eligible Employees	75
Total Valid Votes	68
IBT-AD	32
Write-in ALPA	1
“No” Votes	35

The Board further finds that: the Carrier and employees in this case are, respectively, a Carrier and employees within the meaning of the RLA, as amended; this Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and the interested parties, as well as the Carrier, were given due notice of the Board's investigation.

On the basis of the investigation and report of election which establishes that a majority of the valid votes cast was for no representation, the Board finds no basis for certification and the application is, therefore, dismissed subject to Part 1206.4(a) of the NMB Rules.
