Beyond 500 miles of Metro Detroit area in Michigan, hearings are typically available by Videoconferencing. If the parties prefer, and at the arbitrator's discretion, hearings may be in-person at locations beyond 500 miles.

RATES/POLICIES

Per Diem: \$1,500.00

If a confirmed hearing date is cancelled the fee is:

\$500.00-If notice is provided three weeks or more in advance;

\$900.00-If notice is provided less than three weeks and more than one week;

\$1500.00- if notice is provided one week or less before confirmed date.
