The services of the National Mediation Board (NMB) were invoked by Robert Anderson (Petitioner) on February 28, 2023, alleging a representation dispute under the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, among personnel described as “Fuelers,” employees of PrimeFlight Aviation Services, Inc. (PrimeFlight). The Petitioner seeks to decertify the employee’s incumbent representative, United Service Workers Union, Local 74 (USWU). The USWU was voluntarily recognized by the Employer in June 2005 as the collective bargaining agent of the employees performing the work of fueling and mechanic services at the Orlando International Airport (MCO).

The Board assigned Josie G.M. Bautista to investigate. During the pre-docketing investigation, the USWU by letter dated April 21, 2023, disclaimed interest in representing the Fuelers employed by PrimeFlight at the MCO location and stated that it will no longer act in furtherance of its recognition as the bargaining representative of the Fuelers. Subsequently, by letter dated April 25, 2023, the Petitioner withdrew its Application in File No. CR-7240 in light of the Organization’s disclaimer of interest in representing the Fuelers at MCO.

On the bases of the Organization's disclaimer and the Petitioner's withdrawal request, the Board hereby converts this matter to NMB Case No. R-7612 and dismisses the application.
